We will be attaching plates to the top of the ramp hinges to prevent the ramps from separating from the landings at high tides. The plates are being fabricated, and as soon as we receive them I will form a work party to start the installation.

The Aid to Navigation light has arrived and we are waiting on the daymarker. As soon as we get all the parts a work party will design and fabricate a bracket for installation at the wave maze.

Waterside News Flash:

At the February HOA meeting, the Board requested and approved the formation of a "Waterside Use Committee" to explore issues surrounding fair and safe use of the Waterside common area, as well as more clearly define rules of use. It is expected that the outcome and recommendations of this committee will be used to present homeowners clear guidelines as to how the Waterside common area may and may not be used.

The first meeting took place on Tuesday, March 8th, with a good healthy discussion on a variety of topics specific to Waterside use. It was unanimously decided the best approach would be to obtain input from Homeowners as to their specific concerns and opinions pertaining to the best way to use our docks while preserving safety and good neighborly relations.
