Roger Pollard hosted a contractor walkthrough for potential bidders on this year's siding and paint work. Four construction contractors: Draeger Construction, Community Reconstruction Services, Nielsen Construction and Silicon Valley Builders Group attended and will bid on the siding work. Four painting contractors: Broocker Painting, Ekim Painting, Lupe's Painting, Draeger Painting and Empire Painting will bid on painting this year.

Bids are due back on June 17th and Roger will provide a bid comparison summary and commentary back to us on June 19.

Siding repair will be complete in August, painting in September.

Waterside Committee by Mili Delbecq

Rob Larsen has agreed to continue as Chairman of the Waterside Committee and Mili Delbecq will act as liaison between Rob and the Board. A survey of the waterside of our homes has been completed with reference to areas that may be safety hazards and/or need maintenance work. Some of the homes need repair or replacement of railings. Jeff Frankel is working to obtain quotes for this work, but there appears to be few contractors that are interested.



During the Waterside survey it was observed that many of the homes have had electrical outlets installed on the landings/decks and that many of these outlets appear to be potential safety hazards. Courtesy letters will be sent to each of these owners describing the specific issue and requesting that they take the steps needed to remedy the problem.

In addition, railings on Tideway that were missed when the houses were painted will be included in the painting rotation for this year. It was also noted that a few landings need fascia board replacement etc. and the Board will be addressing getting these repairs made.
