Did you know your smart phone can be an important tool to help you prepare?

Take the first step toward emergency preparedness by downloading the FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) phone app.

Many people use mobile applications to receive updates on severe weather, help plan for emergencies, and stay informed of community activities.

The Disaster Information Management Research Center compiled apps from various organizations to help you find appropriate and trustworthy apps including those from FEMA and the American Red Cross

Red Cross Apps include: Family Reunification; Chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and hazardous substances; Medical information; Responder support; Psychological health tools and Safety training.

US Federal agencies, and surveillance and Alerts such as disease outbreaks and severe weather warnings.

Having preparedness information and planning tools literally at your fingertips is an easy way to take action now.

No Wake Means No Wake, by Jeff Frankel

The last few years have seen a dramatic increase in swimmer, small boat, personal watercraft and paddleboard traffic in the Ballena Isle channel. This is a reminder that the law and commonsense dictate that the 5 MPH **AND** No Wake restrictions are to be observed at all times.

The law says in part: "The maximum speed for motorboats within 100 feet of a bather and within 200 feet of a bathing beach, swimming float, diving platform or lifeline, passenger landing being used, or landing where boats are tied up is 5 miles per hour."
